The Collaborative: Ypsilanti YMCA Child Development Center is open for enrollment. The Collaborative is a great resource for YHC families in need of affordable, high quality, nearby childcare. Studies show that preschool enrollment helps to close achievement gaps in reading, lowers the likelihood of a child repeating grades, and increases the likelihood of a child graduating from high school. The Collaborative is open to children between the ages of 18 months and 5 years and is open from 6:30am-6:30pm. They are located at Chapelle Elementary, which is within walking distance of most YHC communities. Cost is based on income and scholarships are available.
