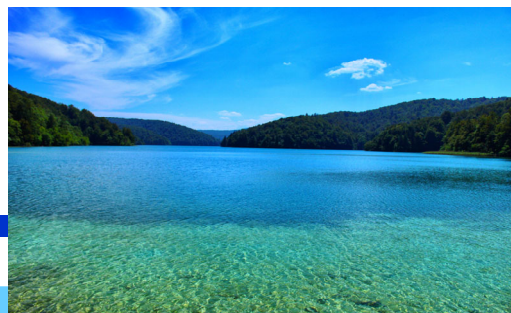

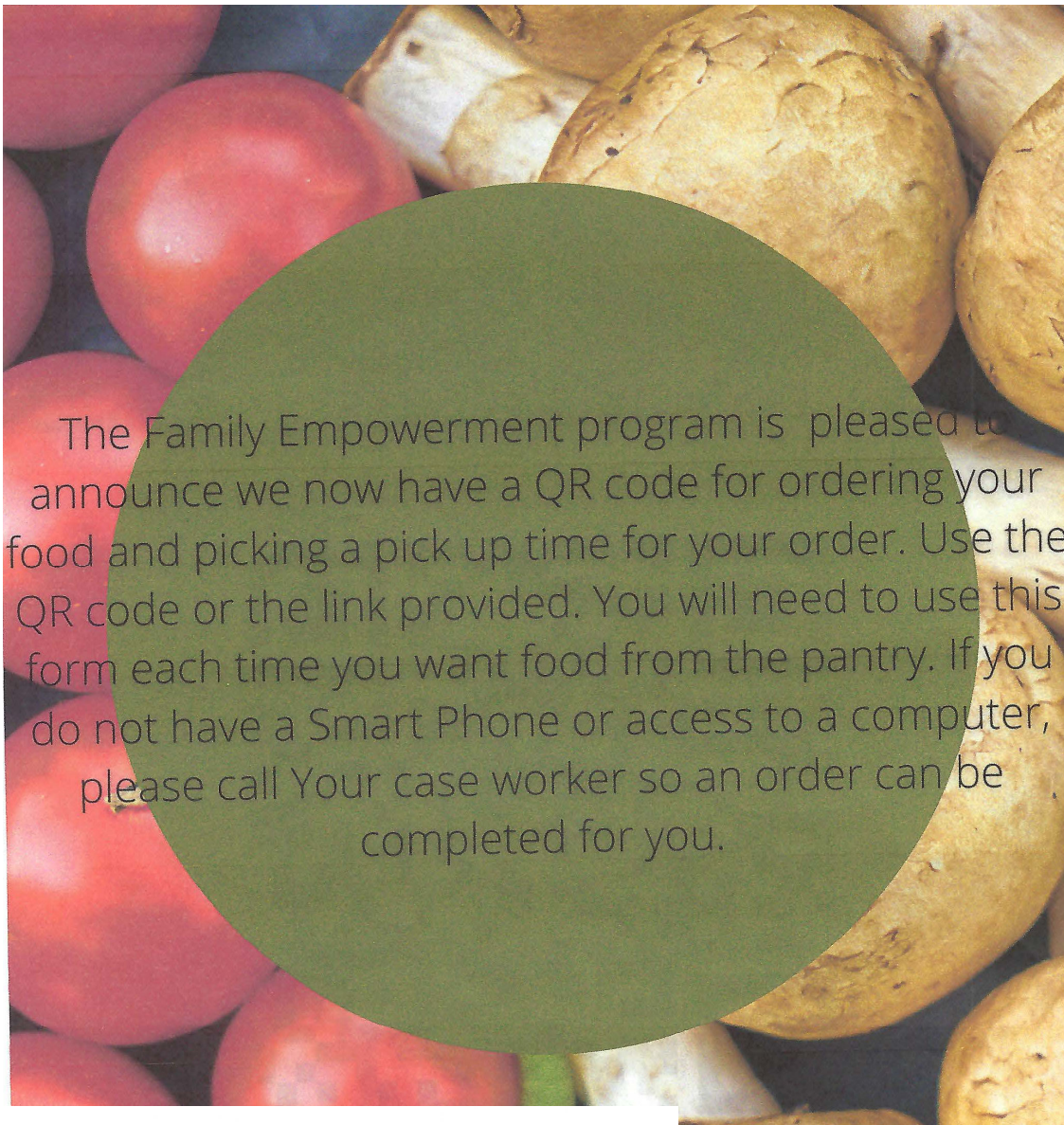
Happy Mother's Day
