




Summer is here and so are many great opportunities for YHC residents!



#### Sat Jun 8 from 12 noon to 4 pm





#### @ EASTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY

#### Calling all soon-to-be 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students!

The King-Chavez-Parks (KCP) College Day program at Eastern Michigan University will be offering a SAT Test Prep series this summer. The intensive workshop series is dedicated to preparing students to meet the challenges awaiting them on the SAT. Our program has partnered with test training professionals from Kaplan to deliver subject-specific curriculum that breaks the SAT down to its basic parts, revealing the skill sets needed to successfully navigate the exam, and reducing the anxiety associated with standardized test taking.

The KCP College Day SAT Test Prep series runs from July 2019 to August 2019. The series will take place on the campus of Eastern Michigan University.
