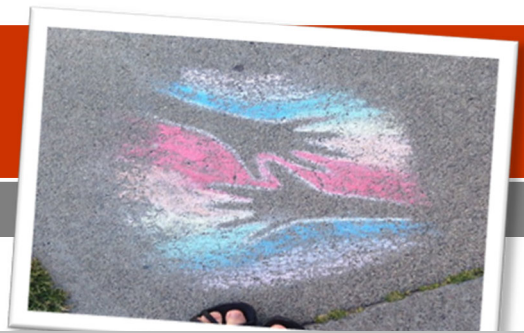

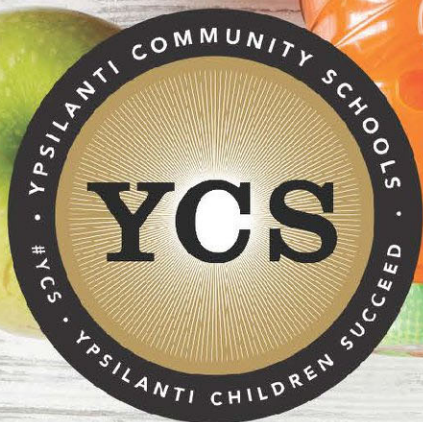

Washtenaw County Health Department (WCHD) is providing flu vaccines with **no out-of-pocket cost**. Everyone 6 months & older is eligible. Flu vaccine is recommended **EVERY** year for **EVERYONE** 6 months & older.

Bring any form of identification that shows name and birth date. If you have insurance, please bring your card. We will bill insurance where possible. We will also check for VFC (Vaccines for Children) eligibility.

*Flu shots and immunizations are covered under insurance plans, including Medicare and Medicaid. A co-payment may be required, and insurance cards must be present at the event. \$25 per shot if a person has no insurance.

Immunization shots will also be available for students and staff.

COVID-19: If you or someone in your family has been exposed or tested positive to the Coronavirus two weeks prior to the event dates, we kindly ask that you not attend this event to limit the exposure to others.

- Caseworker letter stating your hardship
- Verification of job loss
- Copy of Cash Assistance Verification
