It's time for your flu shot!



Because of COVID-19, flu shots are especially important this year.

Washtenaw County Health Department (WCHD) is providing flu vaccines with <u>no out-of-pocket cost</u>. Everyone 6 months & older is eligible. Flu vaccine is recommended <u>EVERY</u> year for <u>EVERYONE</u> 6 months & older.

Bring any form of identification that shows name and birth date. If you have insurance, please bring your card. We will bill insurance where possible. We will also check for VFC (Vaccines for Children) eligibility.

- Verification of job loss
- Copy of Cash Assistance Verification
